Elections Study 1984

The Israel Elections Study of 1984 was based on a representative sample of the adult, Jewish population. It was held between 8-12 July 1984 and included 1259 respondents.

The findings are organized according to the structure of the questionnaire. The questionnaire presents questions and possible answers -- the number that appears to the left of each question indicates the punch card position. The numbers to the right of the answers indicate the percentage distribution of each question. The percentage of interviewees that did not respond is indicated below the distribution according to the answers for each question.

The field research was conducted by "Dahaf. The questionnaire was composed by Prof. Asher Arian from the Political Science Department, Tel Aviv University. These data are presented and made available as part of the activities of the Romulo Betancourt Chair of Political Science of Tel Aviv University.
